



## Terms & Condition of the IMI eLearning License

### Definition and introduction

- 1 'IMI' means The Institute of the Motor Industry Ltd.
- 2 'Licensee' means the customer who has paid to use the eLearning on license between agreed dates as invoiced.
- 3 IMI allows unlimited use of the eLearning on the agreed site within the terms of this agreement.
- 4 Access and reproduction of all aspects of the eLearning is unlimited within the confines of the college/school/training centre for the license period.
- 5 Hard paper copies and CD/DVDs may be reproduced.
- 6 Students may use the material off site where it is part of their normal work/studies.
- 7 Resources used after the date of expiry or outside the terms of this license will be deemed illegal and will be pursued vigorously.
- 8 This product is not part of any Copyright Licensing Scheme.

### Warranty

- 9 IMI warrants to licensee that the material will conform to all written performance criteria and that the material shall not have defects in design, materials and workmanship for a period of 3 months from the date of delivery to the licensee. This warranty shall not apply to minor software problems that can be righted within seven days. IMI does not warrant that the use of the eLearning shall be error free or uninterrupted.
- 10 IMI does not warrant in any way whatsoever other parties' software or documentation.
- 11 The warranty provided is a limited warranty and does not apply if:
  - The material is used improperly
  - Damage to materials is caused after receipt
  - Any party other than IMI modifies it.
- 12 Licensee's sole remedy shall be the replacement by IMI due to any non-conformance during this warranty period.
- 13 Except for the express warranties stated in these terms and conditions, IMI disclaims all other warranties or conditions whether expressed or implied by law.
- 14 IMI accepts no liability, in any form, except that to which the law entitles claim against a supplier of software materials.

### Licence

- 15 IMI transfers no title or ownership of software contained within the IMI eLearning product to licensee or any other third party. Except as explicitly set forth in these terms and conditions, licensee shall not use, copy or modify IMI software in any way.
- 16 Neither licenses nor documentation may be transferred or otherwise made available to third parties without the express written consent of IMI.



- 17 IMI eLearning may be used by the licensee only upon grant of a license by IMI. A license is a personal right to use the material and is granted by IMI only upon acceptance of these terms and conditions. The right to use is a right only to execute, load, copy or transmit to the extent necessary for such execution.
- 18 Licensee shall not decompile, reverse assemble, analyse or otherwise examine the material for the purpose of reverse engineering. Updates, modifications and new versions are covered by these terms and conditions and do not require a separate license or additional fees.
- 19 IMI may terminate the license in the event that the licensee is in breach of any of these terms and conditions and fails to remedy such breach within seven days of the sending of a letter, fax or e-mail to licensee informing licensee of such a breach.
- 20 In the event of termination by IMI or licensee, licensee will delete all copies of the material if requested certify in writing that it retains no copies.

### **Intellectual Property Rights**

- 21 IMI shall retain ownership of all intellectual property rights covering materials produced using the material under this license excepting where these rights are assigned for educational use in specified areas.

### **Marketing Rights**

- 22 IMI retains sole marketing rights for software developed under this license, unless otherwise agreed.
